DO YOU INTEND TO, OR HAVE BEEN ABSENT FROM THE UK FOR A PERIOD OF MORE THAN 3 MONTHS?

REMOVAL FROM THE LIST - PATIENTS ABSENT FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM

Your GP practice must remove a patient from their lists where it receives notice to the effect that the person:

- Intends to be away from the United Kingdom for a period of at least three months
- Has been absent from the United Kingdom for a period of more than three months.

On your return, you will be able to re-register.
