at risk.

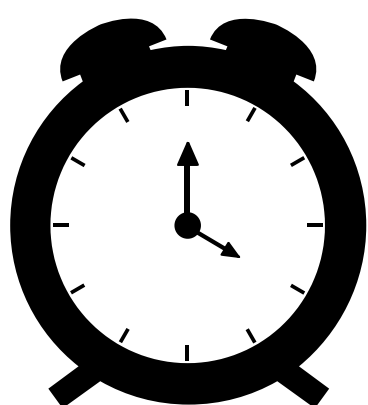

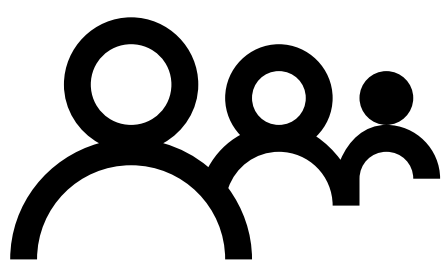

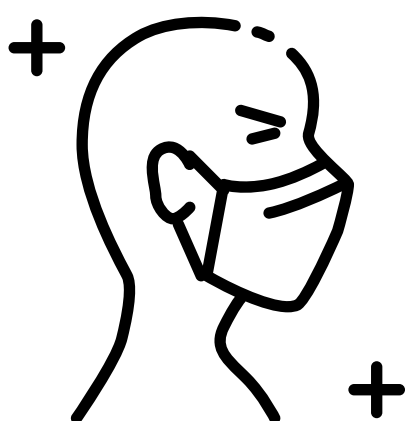
1 APPOINTMENTS

Every patient will need a pre-booked appointment to have a flu jab. By attending at your appointment time, you can help us maintain social distancing and minimise queuing. We will be checking appointment details before entry to the car park.



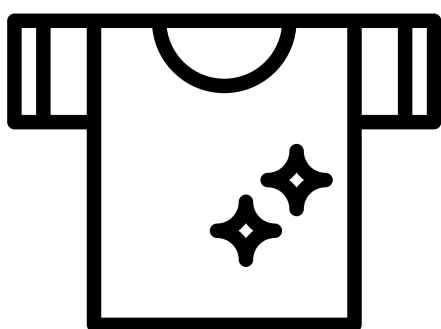
2 SOCIAL DISTANCING

We are allowing more time per patient, and running more clinics, to limit the number of people in the building at any one time. Queues will have space between households, and we are using the Olive Bowl because it has a lot of space.



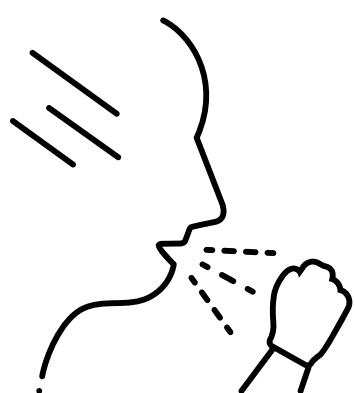
3 FACE MASKS AND PPE

All of our team will be wearing PPE and face masks and adhering to the latest infection control guidance. Please help us by wearing your own face mask or face covering when you arrive at the clinic. There will be plenty of hand gel available.



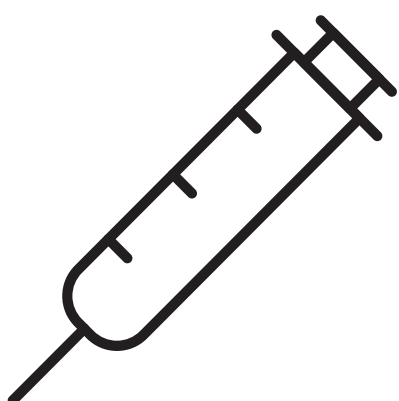
4 WHAT TO WEAR

It really helps if you can wear clothes that make your arms easily accessible. Short sleeves are ideal, without too many layers.



5 IF YOU ARE UNWELL

Please do not attend the clinics if you have a temperature, cough, or have lost your sense of smell or taste. We will screen you for these symptoms before entry, and you will not be able to have the jab. You will be able to rebook for another day, so please stay at home and arrange a COVID test.



6 WHICH JABS?

Patients aged over 65 will receive a different flu vaccine to those aged under 65, in line with national guidance. We will also be providing the pneumococcal and shingles vaccines for eligible patients, where practical.
